Event Nos. 1 and 2 are qualifiers for the 2011 Osborne Refrigerators BDS National Championships. The highest placed turnout owned and driven by a member of the British Driving Society and eligible for the (a) single hackney-type; (l) single turnout driven to a two-wheel exercise vehicle; (m) single turnout driven to a four-wheel exercise vehicle; (o) single turnout driven to a traditional type vehicle by a young driver aged 10-14 years; (p) single turnout driven to a traditional type vehicle by a young driver aged 15-17 years disregarding those already qualified down to 6th place in the class, will qualify for the 2011 semi-finals. ## RULES

- All owners and riders (and where applicable parents or guardians) of horses/ponies competing in any Jumping Competition in this Show shall be deemed to be subject to the Rules of the British Showjumping Association (2011 edition).
- Competitors and others are recommended to make themselves acquaint with such traffic regulations as may be passed by the Magistrates. These regulations will be duly advertised and prominently signposted throughout the vicinity.
- Sports Events are timetabled according to the Schedule. However, the Management Committee reserve the right to alter or cancel any of the events if necessary and will not be responsible for any loss or damage caused in the field. Competitors must observe the progress and be ready to enter the Showing in time for their competition. Any competitor neglecting to strictly observe this will lose the chance of competing; **there must be no waiting.**
- Competitors must abide by the decision of the Official Measurer.
- Horses will convene in a ring at the West end of the Sports Arena and have their numbers attached.
- There will be no allowance for practising Riding either inside or outside the Showing except in the Competition. Competitors attempting such will be disqualified.
- Riders overdoing the use of their whip on their mounts, or causing any obstruction whatsoever to the competitors will be disqualified immediately.
- The Sports will commence at 1.15 p.m. on Sunday and 8.45 a.m. on Monday. Competitors will enter and leave by the gates at the West side of the Showing.
- Only Judges, Stewards, their Assistants, Attending Members and Officials are allowed in the Showing.
- All competitors and animals taking part in the Competitions do so at their own risk.
- All competitors must co-operate with the organisers in compliance with Health and Safety Regulations and do all that is practicable to ensure the health, safety and welfare of those attending. All exhibitors and attendants must ensure that they conduct themselves in a manner so that they do not put themselves or anyone else at risk.
- The Judge's decision is final in all events.

I make a sincere appeal to Competitors in all Events included in this Sports Schedule for their maximum co-operation in its presentation, especially by being ready to enter the Showing or performance area immediately they are called upon to do so.
