1.	8.00	TURRIFF SHOW OPEN JUNIOR UNAFFILIATED SHOWJUMPING QUALIFIER For ponies 148 cms and under with riders aged 16 and under on the day of the Show. The first six ponies to qualify must jump clear in first round disregarding those already qualified. Although unaffiliated, judged in accordance with Table Single Phase, 325m.p.m. British Showjumping rules; height of jumps 90cms. Final to be held immediately after. Qualifier can be used as a warm up. Entry Fee: £8 per entry. Qualifier winner will receive a sash. Rosettes presented to winners. Qualifiers are also to be held at the Balhagan Equestrian, Cabin Equestrian Centre, Ellands Livery, Findon Riding Club, Mundole Equestrian, Tillyoch Equestrian Centre, Aberdeenshire Pony Club, Caithness Pony Club and Moray Riding Club.

2.	1.45	DRIVING COMPETITION FOR HORSES AND PONIES Exercise Vehicle Singles, Pairs or Tandems horses/ponies 4 years old or over, open to all showing competitors, driving a non-traditional vehicle that would be driven every day for exercise. Pneumatic tyres specifically designed for carriages (i.e. not car tyres) are allowed. Lamps need not be carried. Judging will include general cleanliness, safety of turnout, correct fitting of harness and vehicle suitability. Event Nos. 1 and 2 are qualifiers for the 2019 Osborne Refrigerators BDS National Championships at The British Driving Society National Championships on 21st September 2019. RULES

- All owners and riders (and where applicable parents or guardians) of horses/ponies competing in any Jumping Competition in this Show shall be deemed to be subject to the Rules of the British Showjumping Association (2019 edition).
- Horse/Pony passports must be available for inspection by officials on request.
- Competitors and others are recommended to make themselves acquaint with such traffic regulations as may be passed by the Magistrates. These regulations will be duly advertised and prominently signposted throughout the vicinity.
- Sports Events are timetabled according to the Schedule. However, the Management Committee reserve the right to alter or cancel any of the events if necessary and will not be responsible for any loss or damage caused in the field. Competitors must observe the progress and be ready to enter the Showing in time for their competition. Any competitor neglecting to strictly observe this will lose the chance of competing; **there must be no waiting.**
- Competitors must abide by the decision of the Official Measurer.
- Horses will convene in a ring at the West end of the Sports Arena and have their numbers attached.
- There will be no allowance for practising Riding either inside or outside the Showing except in the Competition. Competitors attempting such will be disqualified.
- Riders overdoing the use of their whip on their mounts, or causing any obstruction whatsoever to the competitors will be disqualified immediately.
- The Sports will commence at 1.15 p.m. on Sunday and 8.00 a.m. on Monday. Competitors will enter and leave by the gates at the West side of the Showing.
- Only Judges, Stewards, their Assistants, Attending Members and Officials are allowed in the Showing.
- All competitors and animals taking part in the Competitions do so at their own risk.
- All competitors must co-operate with the organisers in compliance with Health and Safety Regulations and do all that is practicable to ensure the health, safety and welfare of those attending. All exhibitors and attendants must ensure that they conduct themselves in a manner so that they do not put themselves or anyone else at risk.
- The Judge's decision is final in all events.

I make a sincere appeal to Competitors in all Events included in this Sports Schedule for their maximum co-operation in its presentation, especially by being ready to enter the Showing or performance area immediately they are called upon to do so.
