2. No passengers permitted unless vehicles have a passenger seat.
3. Entrance to the Showground is via the main show car park. Please follow the road signage directing you to the Show Car Park. There is no access to the show car park through the Queen's Road gates on show days. 4. All Exhibitors must provide a valid Certificate of Motor Insurance for their vehicles or a Public Liability Insurance Certificate for any stationary engines.
5. **EXHIBITS WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED FROM EXHIBITORS WHO HAVE RETURNED COMPLETED ENTRY FORMS ALONG WITH THE COMPLETED RISK ASSESSMENT (ONLY ONE RISK ASSESSMENT REQUIRED FOR AN ENTRY NOT PER VEHICLE) AND RELEVANT INSURANCE CERTIFICATION FOR EACH VEHICLE.**
6. Entrance to the Showground with a Vintage Vehicle is by means of an official VINTAGE VEHICLE SHOW CAR PARK HANGING TICKET, which will be issued to exhibitor in advance. One pass will admit one vehicle. **Vehicles will not be given access unless they are entered in advance and have the relevant CAR PARK PASS.**
7. All exhibits must be within the showground and stationary by 10.00am on Sunday.
8. Any engines which are switched on must be supervised at all times by a responsible adult and never be left unattended.
9. **JUDGING WILL COMMENCE AT 11AM – JUDGE MAY NOT NECESSARILY MAKE THEMSELVES KNOWN TO EXHIBITORS.**
10. Prizes will be awarded in each category as follows: 1st £40 2nd £30 3rd £20 4th £10
11. **PRIZE MONEY WILL BE PAID TO YOUR NOMINATED ACCOUNT - PLEASE PROVIDE BANK DETAILS**
12. Entry Fee £5 per vehicle
13. First Aid Fee £1 for the total entry

During this process it is essential that all exhibitors follow the instructions of the Senior Vintage Vehicle Convenor and his team, TDAA Health & Safety Consultant and our security marshalls and police if applicable. Anyone refusing to follow instructions will not be permitted to enter future shows - This will be applicable to all those taking part in the Showground Parade and "Y" should be entered - if you will only have a static vehicle or a stationery engine then this will not be applicable and "N" should be entered. |
