- 4. All Exhibitors must provide a valid Certificate of Motor Insurance for their vehicles or a Public Liability Insurance Certificate for any stationery engines.
- 5. EXHIBITS WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED FROM EXHIBITORS WHO HAVE RETURNED COMPLETED ENTRY FORMS ALONG WITH THE COMPLETED RISK ASSESSMENT (ONLY ONE RISK ASSESSMENT REQUIRED FOR AN ENTRY NOT PER VEHICLE) AND RELEVANT INSURANCE CERTIFICATION FOR EACH VEHICLE.
- 6. Entry to the show ground with a vintage vehicle requires an **official Vintage Vehicle Show Car Park Hanging Ticket** (issued in advance). One pass admits one vehicle. No access will be granted without prior entry and a valid Car Park Pass.
